SENSATIONAL NEW 4-4-2 DELIVERS SUPERB PERFORMANCE





The Oldsmobile 4-4-2 (also known as the 442) was produced by Oldsmobile between the 1964 and 1980.

The model was introduced as an option package for US-sold F-85 and Cutlass models and it became a model in its own right from 1968 to 1971, spawned the Hurst/Olds in 1968, then reverted to an option through the mid-1970s. The name was revived in the 1980s on the rear-wheel drive Cutlass Supreme and early 1990s as an option package for the new front-wheel drive Cutlass Calais.





The '64 4-4-2 essentially was is a ' sport coupe version of the BO9 Police Apprehender Pursuit Package with more class, attitude, and chrome. It packed a 330ci

V8 equipped with a 4-bbl. carburetor, dual exhaust, and backed by a 4-speed manual. Hence the term, 4-4-2.

Over the years that definition would change, and even the hyphens would go away for good after 1965. Throughout the '60s and into the early 70's we would see 442's with ram-air, rear spoilers, and engines up to 455ci.



Unfortunately, the oil embargoes of the 70s would have an impact on performance, and by the end of the decade we would see

downsized versions packing 6-cylinder power plants. The 442 would go away for a several years during the early '80s, but would make a return for 1985 with a new body and mandatory 307 V8 power.
