NC Statutes for Classic and Antique Cars and Other Facts

Definition of a classic car is similar to that of antique cars:

A car is considered a classic in North Carolina if it's at least 30 years old. Noted that a stipulation that vehicle should have been manufactured no earlier than 1925.

Cars considered to be vintage, were manufactured between 1919 and 1930.

In 2019, Gov. Roy Cooper redefined a "historic vehicle" under state law from one that's at least 35 years old to one that's at least 30. That means the owners of vehicles made as recently as 1993 can now qualify for an "antique auto" license plate.

20-79.4 Issuable for a motor vehicle that is at least 30 years old measured from the date of manufacture. The plate for an historic vehicle shall bear the word "Antique" unless the vehicle is a model year 1943 or older. The plate for a vehicle that is a model year 1943 or older shall bear the word "Antique" or the words "Horseless Carriage"

105-330.9 Allows antique vehicles to be appraised at no more than \$500.00. This statute was first passed in 1995. It is registered with the Division of Motor Vehicles and has an historic vehicle special license plate under **G.S. 20-79.4**. It is maintained primarily for use in exhibitions, club activities, parades, and other public interest functions.

20-63 Any motor vehicle of the age of 35 years or more from the date of manufacture may bear the license plates of the year of manufacture instead of the current registration plates, if the current registration plates are maintained within the vehicle and produced upon the request. Owner is to keep the registration plates assigned to such motor vehicle reasonably clean and free from dust and dirt.

20-183.2 Vehicles shall not be subject to a safety inspection pursuant to this Article: Historic vehicles, as defined in **G.S. 20-79.4(b)(63)**.

Custom Built Vehicle

Completely reconstructed or assembled from new or used parts.

Will be branded as "reconstructed" with a notation of "specially constructed" on the front of the title. Year of vehicle will be year of assembly.

Replica Vehicle

A replica manufactured from a kit and sold unassembled.

Titled as the make and year of model intended to be replicated.

"Specially constructed" will be noted on the front of the title.

Low Speed Vehicle

Operated only on streets and highways where the posted speed limit is 35 mph or less.

May cross a road or street at an intersection with a posted speed higher than 35 mph.


Must be equipped with headlamps, stop lamps, turn signal lamps, tail lamps, reflex reflectors, parking brakes, rearview mirrors, windshields, windshield wipers, speedometer, seat belts and a vehicle identification number.

Two door "Sport Coupe" (a two-door hardtop - The car has no pillar between the front and back window when the window lowered)

Sport Sedan (a four door hardtop)

Two door Utility Sedan, a two-door sedan with a package shelf instead of a rear seat

Delray "Club Coupe", which was a Two-Ten model 2-door sedan with a deluxe interior



The top-of-the-line two door Bel Air Nomad station wagon with a sloped pillar behind the hardtop door and sliding windows at the rear seat, unique ribbed roof sheet metal and lower roofline height mimicking the hardtop models.

The basic two door Handyman station wagon with an upright sedan B-pillar and a C-pillar, where the four-door wagons have one, available only in 150 and 210 trims.

Four door, six-passenger station wagon (referred to as the Townsman; available in both the 210 and Bel Air series)

Four door, nine-passenger station wagon (referred to as the Beauville; only available in the 210 series)



The 1957 Chevrolet has been called "Baby Cadillac" by some.
