The Tech Page 'Don't Forget' — By, David Smith

When changing breaker points on a distributor, do not forget to place a small amount of distributor cam lube on one lobe of the cam. This reduces the rubbing block wear and keeps the dwell within spec longer.

The strength of anti-freeze needs to be checked with the liquid temp between 60 & 70 degrees for the test to be accurate. Any reading above or below that temp range will be inaccurate.

Always keep your battery connections clean...don't forget the other ends that the cables connect to.



When replacing plugs, always use anti-seize compound on the plug threads and the wire connections with dielectric grease.

When removing a drive belt, mark it's rotational direction so it can be placed in the same direction. If installed in the reverse direction, the belt may have the potential of excessive stretching and fall off.

Any bolts that are removed should have the threads gently cleaned on a wire wheel and coated with anti-seize compound before reinstallation. This helps to assure that the correct torque is being applied when tightening. The studs on the wheels should have the same done to them.

If there is a heat riser installed, free it up with penetrating oil then treat the shaft / moving parts with a high temperature spray lubricant.



Lubricate rubber parts with a high quality spray silicone.

When checking the reservoir on the master cylinder, wipe or spray the cover with brake cleaner to prevent any dirt that may drop into the reservoir.



Always clean your funnels before adding any fluids to your engine. Airborne dirt and cross contamination will pollute the fluid and could have serious consequences.

Well as always, keep the shiny side up and the dirty side down.



The Trivia Page - The Kurtis Sports Car



The Kurtis Sport is a classic American sports car that was produced by Kurtis Kraft from 1949 to 1955. This car was designed by Frank Kurtis and powered by a 4.0-liter V8 engine that produced 200 horsepower. The car was built on a tubular chassis with a lightweight aluminum body and featured an advanced suspension system. The Kurtis Sport was a high-performance sports car that was capable of achieving speeds of up to 140 mph.

The Kurtis Sport 1949 was built using state-of-the-art engineering techniques and was one of the most advanced sports cars of its time. The car featured a unique independent suspension system that used torsion bars rather than traditional springs. This system provided excellent handling and stability. The It had a 1949 Ford chassis, suspension, brakes and V8 engine. Body panels were mostly aluminum over a steel frame, with some steel and fiberglass also used.

After Frank Kurtis realized that the car was not sustainable financially, largely due to production costs, he sold the KSC's manufacturing rights, along with its blueprints, parts, and tooling, to Earl "Madman" Muntz for \$200,000 in 1950. By that time, only 18 to 36 KSCs had been produced.






